**Methods Used to Determine Which Students Receive Aid and How Much**

**Round 1 – Automatic Disbursement**

To receive an automatic disbursement through the HEERF II/CRRSAA program, a JCU student must:

- Have a 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the Financial Aid Office.
- If selected, must have completed federal verification requirements.
- Must be a US citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- Must have an expected family contribution between \$0-\$5,711.
- Must be currently enrolled in courses to receive funding.

**Round 2 – Emergency Grant Application**

If you do not receive an automatic disbursement based on need in Round 1, you can submit an emergency grant application in Round 2. To receive an emergency grant through the HEERF II/CRRSAA program, a JCU student must:

- Have a 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the Financial Aid Office.
- If selected, must have completed federal verification requirements.
- Must be a US citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- Must be currently enrolled in courses to receive funding.
- Certify the request for funding is due to COVID-19 circumstances.
